Procedures for Admissions

Step 1: Schedule a Private Tour

We are delighted to offer tours of our school's buildings (Pre-school, Elementary and Middle) to families interested in enrolling. Please call us to schedule a tour. (504.896.4500)

Step 2: Fill out an Application

Applications will be accepted for the 2018-2019 school year beginning on January 04, 2018. Please remember that your \$50.00 application fee will be due with your application as well as the most recent progress reports available for your child. (If child is not currently enrolled at a day care facility or school, please include a letter of reference/introduction.)

Step 3: Schedule an Interview

Our main office will contact you to schedule an interview. Interviews are typically held in the morning between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.

Step 4: Schedule the Assessment

Applicants (age dependent) are required to visit a class with the appropriate grade level teacher, at which time an assessment is made to determine each student's probability of success in the class. Included in the visit may be a readiness assessment and/or a language proficiency exam.

Step 5: Acceptance

The Admissions office sends out letters of acceptance following the results of the visit and/or assessment in addition to the recommendation of the Admissions Committee. Return of the Enrollment Agreement and Tuition Contract and \$2000.00 Tuition Installment are due upon acceptance to secure placement for your child. School Fees will be due in March of 2018. If we do not receive the listed documents and payments by the given deadlines, your child's place will be relinquished to a student on our waiting list. The payment of school tuition installment and fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
