

Tuition Assistance

Tuition Assistance is available to all students for the 2022-2023 school year. Awards are given based on financial need.

Families should indicate interest early in the enrollment period in January. Applications are filed through the Financial Aid system through www.tads.com. The Tuition Assistance Committee considers recommendations provided by TADS to make all final award determinations after an application is complete and fully processed by TADS. Applications considered in "POOR" status by TADS may require further documentation before being reviewed.

Tuition Assistance is awarded on an annual basis. Returning families must reapply each year. Tuition Assistance awards funding is limited; therefore, it is important to apply for Tuition Assistance as early as possible.

Tuition Assistance awards can range from 5% of tuition to 75% of tuition for those who qualify. Awards cover tuition only and do not include any fees (supplies, books, facilities, lunch, insurance, after school programs or clubs, out-of-town trips, before or aftercare, etc.), all of which must be paid in full by the family.

Application deadlines:

- **January 14, 2022:** TADS application opens
- **January 31, 2022:** Re-enrollment contract due with \$2,000 per child non-refundable and non-transferable tuition installment (If you have submitted an application for assistance and your application status is labeled as "GOOD" by TADS, the non-refundable and non-transferable tuition installment is reduced to \$1,000 per child)
- **April 1, 2022:** Non-refundable and non-transferable school fees are due. Tuition Assistance applications will be reviewed once the TADS application status is labeled "GOOD" or "FAIR" by TADS and all documents have been received.

When possible, final award notification will be provided within two to three weeks after the completed application has been submitted. If an application is not approved for an award by the Tuition Assistance Committee, families will be responsible for the entire tuition amount.

Acceptance of a financial award is only confirmed by returning a signed copy of the award determination letter within 10 business days following receipt of the award letter.

Please be advised that all financial information is held confidential by the Tuition Assistance Committee and business office personnel. Families are required to keep financial awards private. Ecole Bilingue reserves the right to revoke the awarded amount if false or inaccurate information is provided.
