- be willing to build co-teaching units with French teachers
- be willing to contribute to school activities outside of the assigned classroom

- possess strong understanding of the developmental level of the students he or she teaches
- genuinely love to work with children and educators at the elementary level

While French is not a requirement for the position, knowledge of French is a plus and an appreciation for the acquisition of World Languages and global experiences is a must.

Responsibilities:
